Below you will see small section's of a couple of the Teachers work sheet's /score, plus a small section of a group's part, and student work sheet

- 4 = 4 crotchet counts to a bar
- ♪ = One quaver (1/2 a beat) 2 quavers make one full beat
- Count 8 quaver beats to yourself when incorporating quavers to crotchets. 1 crotchet = 1 beat
- Only play/clap when a number is circled or the & sign appears.






Rhythm Clapping Work Sheet 3 - Quavers

Question 2 What is the musical value of a quaver note?
Is it A) one and a half beats B) half a beat C) one beat?

Question 3 How many quaver beats will fit in a musical bar of 4?
Is it A) 7 beats B) 2 beats C) 8 beats?
